RULES FOR KIDS

Hi there!

You have just moved into Harbor Lights, or you have been here some time.

The Grown-ups have a big book of rules that they have to read and obey when they move in here. It is very long and too much for you to read, so some of the rule are written to make it easier for you.

1. Playground Area

The Playground area is the basketball court, the old cabana floor, swings, volleyball court and some of the grass near the playground. You can play basketball there, but no games where you throw the ball and hurt someone. On your way to play with your ball, don't bounce it in the hallways, or on the walkways. Bounce only at the playground area.

You cannot play baseball, it is too near the windows.

Please don't play loud screaming games, or yell when you are on the grass next to the buildings.

Please play nicely with each other and don't bully anyone.

It is not nice to fight, and the Security man will come and scold you.

Take your turn to use the swings.

Dont swing the babies too high or roughly.

When it gets dark you have to go home to your house.

2. Noise

At 8 o'clock at night, everyone has to be quiet until 8 o'clock in the morning. That's because we have a lot of people living here, close together. So, please don't go out and stamp your feet and whistle and yell in the parking lots, or on your way to buy a soda from the machine. When you are going to school in the morning, please try to be quiet.

Please don't yell at the windows for your friends to come out. Go and knock at their doors.

3 Rubbish

When you have bought your candy, please don't throw the wrapper on the floor, take it home or put the wrapper in the trash bins. Your empty soda cans must be thrown away in the recycle bins, or take them home (you can get 5 cents for each one)

Don't throw rubbish in the hallways.

Try not to shishi in the elevators, or stairwells. It is not a very nice smell, and the floor will be wet and slippery and cause accidents.

4. Swimming Pool

Come to the pool with your parents or a responsible other person (Aunty, Uncle, Big Sister, Brother, Cousin...) You are not allowed to be in the Pool by yourself.

Shower before you go in. Wear a swimsuit. Bring a towel. You can bring a floater if you need one.

Don't play bombing. Don't play Marco Polo, it makes too much noise. Try not to scream too much.

Try not to shishi in the pool. It makes it very dirty for the other people and takes a long time to clean thousands and thousands of gallons of water. There are bathrooms at the pool.

When you are finished wipe yourself with your towel, and be sure not to drip

in the hallways and elevators and on the way to your house. People can fall down on the wet floors.

5. Gates and Parking Lot.

When you are walking out of Harbor Lights go through the small gates, the big gates are for cars.

Use the cross walks, don't walk on the road anywhere. Watch out for cars.

When you are waiting for the bus, be orderly. No fighting or running into the roads.

You are not allowed to play in the parking lot.

These are some of the rules that it would be good to stick to.
