As a reminder, there is a fee of \$250 to recover towed cars. That can be totally avoided by notifying your company/repair people to park in the visitor's parking outside or in the office parking area with a permit. You can see security for a permit after hours. If you are in a loading zone, remember to keep your flashers on and take care of your business within 10 minutes. Unfortunately there are no loading zones in front of B Building. You cannot leave your vehicles for any reason or you will get a fine. Please do not park in your neighbor's assigned stalls. This has become so troublesome for those residents who park near the entrance. Thank you for your cooperation.

The only area that I have concern about regarding house rules is the litter problem. Please teach your children to throw their rubbish away in trash cans to keep the property looking nice. The employees work hard cleaning up after disrespectful individuals who are too lazy to walk to the trash can.

Fireworks and Sparklers, etc. are not permitted on Harbor Lights property including the annex. Please bring your enjoyment to the harbor or elsewhere where it is legal to set off fireworks.
