

Aloha Everyone. As you know we are under a storm watch with probability of being affected in some way by the weather. IF we are affected, the office will be closed in the event of a power outage. The elevators will be brought down to the ground floors and turned off if the electric starts fluctuating until it's safe to return them to service. The swimming pool will be closed if the weather is bad.

Please make sure you have your preparation ready, as the Harbor Lights staff is limited and our main concern should be protecting the property and helping the neediest of our residents. **PLEASE DON'T COUNT ON THE HARBOR LIGHTS STAFF TO HELP PROVIDE ANY TYPE OF SUPPLIES and remember OUR STAFF IS VERY LIMITED.**

If you are in need of assistance and the office is closed the security phone number is 344-1062. It's a cell phone and should be available to you. Please stay safe and make sure you have enough supplies in case the lights go out and there is no elevator service! Those of you who are handicapped or elderly and need to evacuate you can call our security for help.

On another note, our tow company wanted me to remind you once again that per Harbor Lights policy, any vehicles without a current safety sticker, license plate, and Harbor Lights issued parking sticker, the vehicle will be removed from Harbor Lights property INCLUDING THE ANNEX. If you are a new resident or you forgot to register your vehicle you can come to the office and obtain a temporary parking pass to give you a little time to take care of business. Motorcycles and mopeds must be parked within the confines of your parking stall. Any others parked elsewhere on the property will be towed, with the exception of the marked off areas that motorcycle owners are renting.

Please do not stand under someone's window or in your car and shout to the upper floors. This is not only rude, but disruptive to many neighboring units.

Keiki (kids) must be supervised. Please do not let the young ones run around the property, in the parking lots, trash areas, and other off limit areas as described in your house rules book.

REMINDER: Service animals are NOT allowed in the courtyard and pet owners must dispose of their pet's waste.

Please be safe during the storm.
