We are conducting our quarterly pest control and unit inspection starting Tuesday March 14. Please make sure that we have a working key to your unit to avoid a consequential fine for a house rules violation. If you do not have a copy of the house rules, you can come to the office and get a book, or you can view them online at <http://www.harborlightsmaui.com>. All apartments are to be kept clean, free from hazardous materials, plumbing in good repair (no running toilets or drips).

The schedule for pest control is as follows:

A Building 3rd and 4th floors will be Tuesday March 14

A Building 2nd and 1st floors will be Wednesday March 15

B Building Thursday March 16

C Building Thursday March 23

D Building 4th and 3rd floors Tuesday March 21

D Building 2nd and 1st floors Wednesday March 22

I've had several complaints about people leaving trash outside their door and in the stairwells. We have cameras and people leaving trash will be fined. This is your formal warning that you are not to leave trash in the hallways!

Mopeds are beginning to be a problem at Harbor Lights. Just like any other vehicle on the property, in the visitor's stalls or in the annex they must be legally registered or they are not permitted on our property (or annex). You cannot bring mopeds into the buildings. Not only is it against house rules, but it's a serious fire hazard. The same parking rules apply as well. Mopeds not parked in a parking stall will be towed.
